There are two components to referencing: citing within the text of your paper, and the reference list at the end. All sources of information and data, whether quoted directly or paraphrased, are cited with parenthetical references in the text of your paper. It is essential to acknowledge the ownership of resources used in your academic writing. At AUT we use the APA reference style (6th edition) to format references.
