Frederick County is located in the northern part of the U.S. state of Maryland. As of the 2010 U.S. Census, the population was 240,336. The county seat is Frederick. Frederick County Public Schools (FCPS) is a K5-12 public school system serving the residents of Frederick County, Maryland. The system includes several schools to serve the educational needs of the youth in Frederick and the surrounding areas of Frederick County. Enormously dry but complete, this book should be thought of as a reference work. It's not intended to be a narrative history. Written essentially as a record of colonial land transactions, the book also includes brief biographical sketches of the earliest settlers in Frederick County, Maryland. An unusual characteristic about Frederick is, despite a relatively small size, it is home to two medium-sized shopping malls. Frederick Towne Mall, located on the "Golden Mile" retail strip of U.S. 40 on the west side of town, was the first mall in town, and opened to massive fanfare in 1972.
