In narratology and comparative mythology, the monomyth, or the hero's journey, is the common template of a broad category of tales that involve a hero who goes on an adventure, and in a decisive crisis wins a victory, and then comes home changed or transformed. Joseph Campbell first wrote of the hero's journey - which he also called the Monomyth - in his book, *The Hero With A Thousand Faces*. His basic premise was that every myth and story follows the same steps; and that these steps somehow resonate within us as humans, and we respond to that kind of story. Treasure, love, reward, approval, honor, status, freedom, survival ... these are some of the many things we associate with the hero's journey. Searching For The Hero Jung and Campbell aren't the only people who have attempted to map the Hero's Journey! There have been dozens of less celebrated forays into this area, and just about everyone comes to slightly different conclusions.
