A Dragon Lady is usually a stereotype of East Asian and occasionally South Asian and Southeast Asian women as strong, deceitful, domineering, or mysterious. The term's origin and usage is Western, not Chinese. Empress Xiaozhen (29 November 1835 – 15 November 1908), of the Manchu Bordered Yellow Banner Yehe Nara clan, personal name Xingzhen, was a consort of the Xianfeng Emperor.
