Sir Henry Rider Haggard, KBE, Kt (/ ˈ h æ ? ʔ r d /; 22 June 1856 – 14 May 1925) was an English writer of adventure novels set in exotic locations, predominantly Africa, and a pioneer of the Lost World literary genre.
