The sole issue in this case is whether a yacht insurance policy purchased by plaintiff provided coverage for his vessel while it was at sea, a few miles from San Francisco Bay. Glens Falls Insurance Company found it necessary to construct a larger building to accommodate its increased business. In the spring of 1912 company officials offered to present their old building to both Lodges, if the Lodges would move the building from its present location.
