They are the subtypes of Shoola. Shula means pain or colic, used to describe abdominal pain to be precise. They are the subtypes of Shoola. The term 'Peptic ulcer' is used for all the ulcers - both gastric/esophageal ulcers and duodenal ulcers. 1 The symptoms of peptic ulcer are described well in Ayurvedic texts.
