

Download The Face Of The Third Reich Portraits Of The Nazi Leadership

In a footnote on page 830 of *Rise And Fall Of The Third Reich*, Shirer writes: I learn from Hitler's captured daily calendar book that the celebration had been moved from the old Buergerbraukeller, where the putsch had taken place, to a more elegant beer hall in Munich, the Loewenbraukeller. From the time of the so-called Beer Hall Putsch and whilst taking a school group from Naples, Florida on a tour.
