Robotic surgery can be used to treat a variety of urologic concerns. Robotic Radical Prostatectomy. Prostate cancer is the second most common cancer among men, but it can often be treated successfully. Among the options for treating prostate cancer, removal of the prostate gland is often recommended if the cancer has not spread beyond the prostate gland. Urologic Surgery. Traditional open urologic surgery – in which large incisions are made to access the pelvic organs – has been the standard approach when surgery is warranted. Urologic robotic surgery can be used to treat many conditions that affect the male reproductive organs and urinary tract organs, including prostate, bladder and kidney cancer.
